Kick Sledge Tour

**2,5h long soft adventure in frozen
Finnish lake scenery**

On this tour you get to enjoy the feeling of gliding on ice. We will have short break at one of the public fire places by lake Näsijärvi. There we sit down and just listen to the winter sounds of nature. **February is the month when most likely there is nothing to prevent this from happening.**

We recommend the evening time tour especially to those who are interested of the night sky. If we get lucky we might see northern lights. **When the chance of aurora grows, we add tours that might not be on the given schedule.**

How you need to be prepared

is with clothing according to the weather. Warm mittens and woolen hat is a must in winter. We also recommend a bottle of something warm to drink.

What would be a wonderfully easy and safe way to get to enjoy gliding on the ice? The Finnish traditional kick sled is the perfect answer to this. Come and enjoy alone or together, with the family young one on the seat or kicking together if they have the energy. The Näsijärvi tour skating track offers a safe route for us and the camp fire spots to the east seal the atmosphere.

We gather together by Näsijärvi ice, right next to our rental shop (next to the pier, right side when looking from on land). Just a 20-30min walk or bus drive from the city center and you will find yourself from the middle of nature and Kauppi sports area. If our track is open on its fullest, you can take a shortcut through the lake.

From Kaupinoja we start our journey towards the east on a safe and maintained track. The tour offers a good chance to get familiar with our skating track. Our journey continues to one of the eastern camp fire spots (depending on our speed). There we will have some snacks. After enjoying our time by the fire, we will get back to Kaupinoja, where the guided part of the tour will end.

Your guide(s) are Hiking Travel Hit employees, who take part in our weekly company skill training. They participate on ice safety lecture and rescue practice every winter. Know how and customer safety is a thing of heart for us.



To tour operators:

The tour can be organized on other times than the given schedule. If done so, the same prices apply groups of 4 or bigger.

The starting and ending point can be moved to Lapinniemi to serve customers who are staying at the spa hotel.

Every participant can take one bag with them, about the size of a school backpack.
